

Boy Scout Camping Regulations



RESERVATIONS: Weekend camping reservations must be made via our on line reservation system (LCRS) at least 6 days prior to encampment. You are welcome to tour any of our camps *with prior approval from the camping registrar.*

CAMP HOURS: Gates are open from 7:00am to 10:00pm Friday and Saturday and 7:00am to 2:00pm on Sunday. *All units must check in and out with Ranger or camp master.* When checking in, a complete roster of everyone attending must be turned in to the Ranger or camp master.

WATER: Water is available at our camps year-round except for Shuler. Nov. 1 to April 1 water is available from a central water source only.

Campsites are equipped with latrines (not flushing toilets). You can view campsite maps with amenities on our website. www.longhorncouncil.org

LEADERSHIP: Two registered adult leaders one of whom is 21 years of age or older and Youth Protection certified are

required at all times. Certification cards will be required at the time of check in.

THE YOUTH PROTECTION TRAINED PERSON HAS TO BE ON THE PROPERTY AT ALL TIMES. NOBODY WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE PROPERTY UNTIL THOSE TRAINED PEOPLE ARE THERE, AND EVERYONE WILL BE EXPECTED TO CHECK OUT WHEN THOSE TRAINED PEOPLE LEAVE.

The leader in charge assumes responsibility of confining the group to their own campsite and respecting the "lights out" time between 10:00pm and 7:00am.

CAMP FIRES: Use only established fire rings. DO NOT establish new ones. Do not leave fire unattended at any time. No liquids.

CAMPING: Camping may be done only on established sites assigned by the Ranger or Camp master. Male and female leaders require separate sleeping facilities. Married couples may share quarters if appropriate facilities are available. When staying in tents, no youth will stay in the tent of an

adult other than the tent of his or her parent or guardian.

Report all substantial injuries to the Camp Ranger or Camp master.

VEHICLES: Obey the posted speed limit. Rangers are authorized to remove speeders from camp. Parking is permitted only in designated area. Camp Ranger may permit vehicles in the campsite to be unloaded with the vehicle immediately being moved back to the parking area. *ABSOLUTELY NO RIDING IN THE BACK OF PICKUP TRUCKS BY ANYONE!!! Anyone who drives off road at a camp without advance permission from the LHC will be removed from the camp immediately and loose their privilege to use camps.*

PROGRAM: Units are responsible for the success of their weekend. All appropriate certifications will be required by the Ranger before requested equipment is released to the unit..

CONSERVATION: Protect wildflowers and wildlife. Do not cut, blaze or trim live trees. Dead trees may be cut only with the permission of the Ranger or Camp master.

Units are encouraged to contact the Ranger about doing conservation projects.

SWIMMING: Swimming may be done only under the BSA Safe Swim Defense and with the approval of the Ranger. Certified people will need to show certifications upon check in.

DO NOT BRING: Alcoholic beverages, illegal substances, fireworks, pets of any kind, firearms, and ammunition or archery equipment.

HOUSEKEEPING: Keep campsites neat and clean. To prevent erosion damage, do not rake areas, clear underbrush, ditch tents or otherwise alter the natural terrain. Leave grounds, buildings and equipment in good condition. *Do not bury trash or garbage.*

RENTALS AND FEES: Request for rental facilities and equipment must be noted on the LCRS at least 6 days in advance. Damage to equipment and or buildings will be charged to the person or unit responsible. Camp Shuman has an additional per person

port-a-john fee in addition to any camping/program fees.

PORTABLE TOILETS: Camping on the McClure Property (or any property without toilet facilities) at Worth Ranch by Packs is only permitted if the unit makes arrangements for portable toilets.

PETS: No pets allowed on camp property at any time.
