

Troop 127 Personal Equipment List – Weekend Campout
Updated 4/9/2008

- Scout uniform shirt (tan shirt must be worn to/from the campout)
- Scout handbook
- Ink pen
- Duffle bag or backpack
- Sleeping bag & waterproof cover
- Sleeping pad (foam or Therma-Rest)
- Socks – preferably non-cotton (2 pair)
- Waterproof hiking boots or sturdy shoes
- Troop hat or other hat (preferably BSA)
- T-shirt (2 including the Troop T-shirt which is required for Saturday)
- Underwear (2 pair)
- Pants/shorts (2 pair)
- Rain gear (pancho or rain suit – avoid PVC suits)
- Mess kit (plate, cup, fork, spoon)
- Water bottle or Camelbak (fill this and take it with you in car on Friday)
- Pocket knife (only if you have earned and are carrying your Totin' Chip card)
- Flashlight or headlamp (think small – no need to carry a heavy 18" flashlight)
- Compass (keep this in your bag)
- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Biodegradable Soap (travel size)
- Sunscreen (travel size)
- Bug spray (travel size)
- First Aid kit (travel size) – See page 289 of The Boy Scout Handbook
- Chair

For Fall Weather add:

- Troop Sweatshirt or other sweatshirt
- Light jacket/windbreaker (can use raingear for this purpose)
- Long sleeved shirt

For Winter Weather add:

- Long underwear (preferably non-cotton like Duofold or Coldgear)
- Gloves/mittens
- Warm jacket
- Long sleeved shirts (2)
- Stocking cap
- Extra blanket or low temperature rated sleeping bag

Optional:

- Watch
- Camera
- Notebook
